So, what exactly is a "Galactic Starveyor?" "Starveyor" sounds like a word someone made up. At its core, I guess that could be said of any word though. The word "cheeseburger" didn't exist until someone made it up. Anyway, this week at VBS, kids will become Galactic Starveyors as they search the heavens and the Scriptures in order to discover the truth about what God has etched into His handiwork. What do we discover when we study the cosmos and the Word of God? In short, we discover purpose; we discover promise; and we discover relationship.

The relationship began with Creation. The entire universe and everything in it was created so that we might have relationships with one another and with Him.
