I've recently read two significant articles about the challenges facing the church today. One was published in a quarterly, and the other online. The first is entitled America Follows Israel's Departure from God, and the second, America's New Religion: Fake Christianity.

I referred to the online article in a sermon a couple of weeks ago when I pointed out how many Christians have embraced the belief that the purpose of life is to be happy, and we have no right to pass judgement on anyone if they're just trying to be happy. The article gave a name to this fake Christianity, calling it Moralistic Therapeutic Deism.

The moralistic perspective is that we're here to be good people and do good. The therapeutic aspect is everything is supposed to be geared to making me feel good about myself. And deism is the idea that God created the world but has no direct involvement in it. The bottom line is that God just wants everyone to be nice, and the purpose of life is to be happy.

The article in Does God Exist? suggests that the problems we face today are the result of doing five things Jeremiah said God's people were doing in his day. I'm simply going to note them. You can get the details by reading Jeremiah 6:10-19.

- -They refuse to listen to the word of God.
- -They are obsessed with material thinas.
- -They delude themselves with falsehoods.
- -They were not ashamed and could not blush.
- —Thev rejected the only possible solution.

The author concludes: "The politicians and philosophers will not fix what is wrong with our world. The only possible solution is the teaching and example of Jesus Christ taught in our homes and congregations and lived out in the lives of his disciples." I'm sure we all agree.

## **Haitian Christian Ministries**

As Haitians struggle with the aftermath of a devastating earthquake and the recent assassination of their president, we bring you some good news from the mission we support in Haiti.

"In June 2019, a young married man named Walter Gabriel decided to plant a church in an area where voodoo is highly practiced. This area is near a 'dirty pool'. where people come from all over Haiti weekly and annually to take a dirty bath for good luck. This young man of God has been financially supported by the Board of HCM to study theology at Emmaus Biblical Seminary. Pastor Bob says 'I have learned to appreciate his man of God who has left his mother church at Lory in order to reach our to a lost community. His patience and his courage to win souls. baptize followers, and teach them is very encouraging.'

This church plant has grown up from 5 to 50 members. One of the families who submitted their lives to Christ has offered their yard to host the church. Without having their own land, the church is currently meeting under a tent. However, Pastor Walter is looking for a piece of land in the same community to put the church. Because of where the church is geographically, the church was persecuted by a group of witch doctors and community members. Some people of this community see voodoo as a means to gain money. They do not want to have people closely follow Jesus as they will abandon their voodoo practice. Walter's job is not easy, and it requires a great spiritual discipline to enter this spiritual battle. He has experience great Satanic attacks but believes fully 'greater is he that is in me than he that is in the world."
